As the recovery roadmap continues; we need to ready to deliver live meetings and events and we need to ensure customers have confidence in protocols and practices that have been developed, aligned to Covid-19.

Costs:

- What are the costs for HBAA members? HBAA members receive a 30% discount. The course costs are £135 for full course and £65 for corporate course. You can sign up and obtain the discount for a future course

- Who is the full course designed for? Agencies, venues and corporates
- Who in a venue should attend, sales or ops? It is recommended that ops take the full course and sales do the corporate course, as high level
- What is covered within the modules? It is based upon science, risk assessments, case studies, mental health, practices, assignments
- How long will the course take me? Approx 7 hours (allowing 1 hour online training, 4 hours live session and 2 hours for the practical assignment)
